5. Progressive winners:

In the event more than one progressive meter pay hits during the same round, the dealer will first pay the player farthest on the right and then move counter-clockwise to pay other players.

6. Envy Bonus:

- a. A player making the progressive wager also qualifies to win an envy payout. If another player at the table hits a hand associated with an envy pay, all other players who made the progressive wager win the envy pay. The player hitting the hand receives the normal prize pay only, but does NOT receive the envy pay. Rule of thumb: You can't win an envy bonus pay from yourself, or the dealer. A player that folds a hand will still qualify for the envy bonus in the event they made a progressive wager.
- b. If a player's hand triggers an envy payout, the dealer will leave the hand face-up on the layout; otherwise, the dealer will lock up the cards. The dealer will then move on to the next player.
- c. The dealer pays any Envy Bonuses at the end of the round. In the event that more than one player is involved in a qualifying envy pay, then all players win multiple envy payouts.

Let It Ride

Each player places three equal bets in three spaces labeled (1), (2) and (\$). The dealer then deals three cards to each player face down. He also deals two "community" cards face down in front of himself.

Now, take a look at your three cards. If you think you have the beginnings of a good hand, or if you're just feeling lucky, then Let It Ride! If you're not pleased, pull back your first bet.

The dealer then turns over the first community card, which becomes the fourth card in your hand. Again, if you think you have a good hand, Let It Ride! If not, pull back your second bet.

Finally, the dealer turns over the second community card, completing your five-card poker hand. If you've pulled back your first two bets, the third bet has to play. If your five-card hand contains a pair of 10s or better, you win. And you can win big bucks, as you can see by the payout table:

3-CARD BONUS

The 3-Card Bonus bet is an optional bonus bet. The bet is based on your three cards only. The 3-Card Bonus will receive action regardless if you fold your hand. The bet wins with a pair or better. The 3-Card poker hands pay according to the following pay table:

Straight Flush 40 to 1
Three of a Kind 30 to 1
Straight6 to 1
Flush
Pair1 to 1

RULES OF PLAY:

- Let It Ride offers an optional progressive wager. The progressive jackpot wager is an optional \$5 wager that must be made prior to the delivery of the cards.
- 2. The bet considers the best hand possible among all the player's cards.
- 3. The pay table shown has been designed to work on a link together with the games Four Card Poker, Mississippi Stud, and Ultimate Texas Hold'Em.

4. To begin each round, players must make their regular game's wager. They may also place any bonus wagers and the progressive wager. Players must place the progressive wagers on the sensor in front of their betting position. The sensor will light up.
