EVENT DETAILS

- 1) Players start with 10,000 in tournament chips.
- 2) Day 1, levels change every 15 minutes.
- 3) Late registration and re-entries are allowed until the start of level 9. No Refunds.
- 4) Re-entries take priority over alternates.
- 5) A single ante will be paid from the Big Blind for the entire table. The ante is posted prior to the Big Blind.
- 6) A \$1,100 Tournament ticket for the Liberty Bell Poker Open, Event #3 will be awarded for every \$1,100 in the prizepool.
- 7) \$114 from each entrant goes to the prize pool, \$11 is registration fee, \$10 goes towards staffing fee.

HOUSE RULES

- 1) Must be 21 years of age or older to play.
- 2) A player's card will be required for tournament registration. Players must use their player's card at the table.
- 3) Live! Casino and Hotel will follow TDA Rules, any exceptions will be announced.
- 4) Players start with a full stack. Purchased stacks will be put into play at the end of registration if player is still absent. Play will begin with 4 players are checked into the table.
- 5) Winnings over \$5,000 must have a valid I.D.
- 6) Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determine to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without fund. It is each and every player's responsibility to bring to our attention unusual chips, circumstances or irregularities.
- 7) Live! Casino and its affiliates will not be held responsible for typographic errors or misinformation made by on website or printed material pertaining to this event. Players will have no claim in these matters.
- 8) Tournament prize pools may be modified if all remaining players unanimously agrees and the agreement satisfies the rules outlined.
- 9) Management reserves the right to change, or cancel any tournament. On site PGCB will be notified of any cancelations on any tournament.
- 10) Tournament Director's decision is final and without recourse.
