EVENTS DETAILS

- 1) Players start with 30,000 in tournament chips.
- 2) Levels changes every 30 minutes. Day 2 level changes every 40 minutes.
- 3) Re-Entries take priority over Alternates.
- 4) Late registration and re-entries allowed until the start of level 9. No Refunds. Seating may be limited.
- 5) A single ante will be paid from the Big Blind for the entire table. The ante is posted prior to the Big Blind.
- 6) Players may forfeit their stacks at the end of registration to Re-Enter.
- 7) Day 2 is Monday, May 30th @ 12:15 PM and will play to a winner.
- 8) 1 in 8 entries will be in the money. Day 1's conclude once 12.5% remain.
- 9) \$475 from each entrant goes to the prize pool. \$50 is registration fee, \$25 goes towards staff take.

HOUSE RULES

- 1) Must be 21 years of age or older to play.
- 2) A player's card will be required for tournament registration. Players must use their player's card at the table.
- 3) Live! Casino and Hotel will follow TDA Rules, any exceptions will be announced.
- 4) Players start with a full stack. Purchased stacks will be put into play at the end of registration if player is still absent.
- 5) Winnings over \$5,000 must have a valid I.D.
- 6) Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determine to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It is each and every player's responsibility to bring to our attention unusual chips, circumstances or irregularities.
- 7) Live! Casino and its affiliates will not be held responsible for typographic errors or misinformation made by on website or printed material pertaining to this event. Players will have no claim in these matters.
- 8) Tournament prize pools may be modified if all remaining players unanimously agrees and the agreement satisfies the rules outlined.
- 9) Management reserves the right to change, or cancel any tournament. On site PGCB will be notified of any cancelations on any tournament.
- 10) Tournament Director's decision is final and without recourse.
